

# Terms & Conditions

The Theater Camp is operated by Broadway Theater International Association (BTI)

## Booking

It is advised that you make your booking as early as possible as places in the camp are strictly limited. Please note that no course payment should be made prior to the receipt of confirmation of a place being available.

Confirmation of a booking is subject to a deposit payment. The balance of fees is payable by the date indicated on the invoice.

Any bookings must be paid in full 10 days before the start.

The booking of a place is regarded as acceptance of our Terms and Conditions.

## Camp Rules and Regulations

We expect and hope that all young people attending BTI sessions will make every effort to show respect at all times to fellow students and members of the staff. The camp rules outlined below are designed to ensure that all students and staff are able to safely enjoy their stay free from any unpleasant, intimidating or aggressive behavior.

However, any student who consistently breaks the course rules, breaks the law or displays aggressive or intimidating behavior will face instant dismissal from the camp and will return home at their own expense.

- Students are expected to attend all meals, workshops, rehearsals and arranged activities.
- Any damage caused by a student to property, equipment or accommodation will be charged to the student.
- Gratuitous or willful damage to BTI property, public property or other students' property may result in dismissal from the camp.
- Consumption or possession of alcohol by any student is not permitted.
- Smoking is not permitted.
- Drug-taking or possession of drugs will result in instant dismissal from the camp.
  
- Intimidating behavior towards another student or member of staff will result in instant dismissal from the camp.
- Boys and girls may only mix in the designated recreation areas and not enter each others' accommodation
  
- Personal mobile phones must be turned off during all rehearsals and scheduled activities.

## Promotional Materials

At the discretion of the Director, photographs or videos may be taken of students during the session and may be used in promotional material for BTI or on our website.

## **Insurance**

All students attending a BTI camp should have insurance and be in possession of a “Carte Vitale”. Any medical fees advanced by BTI are to be reimbursed by the student’s legal guardian upon presentation of proof of payment.

BTI accepts no responsibility in the event of damage or theft of personal belongings.

## **Liability and Changes**

Broadway Theater International has public liability insurance. Nothing in these terms and conditions shall operate to exclude any liability of BTI for personal injury or death caused by the negligence of the company or those employed by the company.
